## ***SPEAKER BIOGRAPHIES***

### **Keynote Speakers**

#### **Dr. Philemon Choi**

Trained as a medical doctor and psychological counselor, Dr. Philemon Choi is a founding member and currently the General Secretary of Breakthrough. Under his leadership, Breakthrough has developed from one magazine to a multi-media youth organization. He is also active in community affairs, and is appointed by the government as members of various committees related to youth policy and youth services, including the chairman of Commission on Youth, Social Welfare Advisor Committee, Action Committee Against Narcotics, Steering Committee on Parent Education, Fight Crime Committee.

Dr. Choi is a regular seminar speaker on matters related to youth among parent and teachers associations, school services, church fellowships and international conferences. He is also an author of a few best sellers and a regular contributor of youth magazines. His recent titles include Healing Love, Manage Your Life, Father in the Making, Men Behind the Mask, Conquering Fears - To My Sons, Understanding Suffering and Manual for Youth Workers: Shaping Adolescents of the 21st Century.

#### **Dr. Don Page Ph.D.**

Dr. Page is currently the Dean of Graduate Studies and Director of the Masters program in Administration and leadership at Trinity Western University.

He brings a vast array of experience to this position after having been in the ministry close to 40 years. His ministry began in 1962 as a High School teacher in Peterborough Ontario. He went on to finish his Masters and Ph.D. in History at the University of Toronto. He conducted research at Harvard, Columbia, and the Geneva School of International Affairs.

In 1970 he taught History and Political Science at the University of Saskatchewan in Regina and supported the Inter-Varsity Christian fellowship club as their sponsor. In 1973 he began to work in Ottawa with the Department of External Affairs as its Resident Historian. In 1975 he joined the Public



Service as the

Deputy Director for Historical Research in the Department of External Affairs. He began the Public Service Christian Fellowship that grew to 38 Bible Studies and Prayer Groups meeting weekly in 22 Government Departments.

In 1985 he became the Senior Policy Analyst and Speech Writer in the Policy Development Bureau of the Department of External Affairs. Dr. Page drafted the Government's Foreign Policy Statement and wrote speeches for 3 Prime Ministers and 5 Secretaries of State for External Affairs.

He left the public scene to join up with Trinity Western University as the Academic Vice President in 1989. He held that position for 10 years until he began his present position as Dean of Graduate Studies and Director of the Administration and Leadership program.

### **Workshop Speakers**


**Dr. Charles M.C. Lee, Ph. D.**  
**Henrietta Johnson Louis Professor of Management;**  
**Professor of Accounting and Finance**

Dr. Lee is the Henrietta Johnson Louis Professor of Management and Director of the Parker Center for Investment Research. He is a Chartered Accountant from Ontario, Canada, and received his Ph.D. from Cornell University in 1990. From 1990 to 1996, he was a faculty member at the University of Michigan Business School. He was the 1995-96 Visiting Economist at the New York Stock Exchange. He also holds a Certificate in Biblical Studies from Ontario Theological Seminary, and is fluent in Mandarin Chinese.

Professor Lee's research interest encompasses security valuation, financial statement analysis, behavioral finance, and market microstructure. Much of his work has explored the effect of human cognitive constraints on market participants, and the information efficiency of stock markets. Most recently, he has focused on the interaction between fundamental valuation and market sentiment indicators. He has published extensively in major scholarly journals, and his research is frequently featured in the popular press.

Professor Lee has received numerous honors and awards. His teaching honors include two Cornell Johnson School Apple Awards for Teaching Excellence (1997, 2000), the Michigan MBA Teaching Excellence Award (1994), and the Michigan Ph.D. Teaching Excellence Award (1995). Recent research honors include a Graham and Dodd Award of Excellence (1999), two Q-Group research grants (1995, 1993), first place at the 1998 CQA Academic Research Competition, the 1996 IBES Global Expectations Research Competition, and the 1995 CQA-IBES Research Competition.

Professor Lee serves on the Research Advisory Committee of the AAA, the




Program Selection Committee of the WFA, and the Council for Education and Research of the AIMR. He is Co-Editor of the Review of Accounting Studies, Associate Editor of the Journal of Finance, the Journal of Accounting Economics, the Financial Analysts Journal, and the Journal of Financial Markets. He is also consulting editor of the China Finance and Accounting Review, and is a member of the Editorial and Advisory Board of the Accounting Review

**Dr. David Liang, Ph. D.**

Dr. Liang is a senior staff member of the Space Defence, Satellite Communication and Nuclear Radiation section of the Canadian Defence Department. He has a doctoral degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Alberta.

In 1991, the Canadian Defence Department awarded Dr. Liang a special commendation for his extraordinary contributions. He has served on several NATO committees. Dr. Liang has been involved in individual evangelism for many years. He authored the book Winning Strategies and has lectured extensively on predictions of the Bible.

**Dr. Edward Ng, Ph. D.**



Dr. Ng is a senior analyst with the Federal Government of Canada. Active with the campus ministry during his student days in Hong Kong and in Canada, he continued his involvement upon his arrival in Ottawa in the early 1990s with both the Ottawa Canadian Chinese Christian Professional Fellowship and the Public Service Christian Fellowship (co-founded by Dr. Don Page).



**Dr. William H. Wong, Ph. D.**

Dr. Wong is born and raised in Hong Kong and came to know Jesus Christ as his personal Saviour during his high school years. He came to Canada in 1964 to pursue post-secondary education and graduated with BA (Hon.), MA from University of Manitoba, Winnipeg and Ph.D. from University of Alberta, Edmonton.

Employed with Government of Alberta since 1973 in research, planning, evaluation and policy development in demography, immigration, labour market training programs, human services, etc. He is currently in an executive management position in Accountability and Performance Management. He has represented Alberta and Canada in numerous federal-provincial meetings, including international conferences of OECD and the United Nations.


**Ms. Esther Yu**



### **Saturday: Success**

*Matthew 5:5 "Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth."*


We live in a success-saturated world. Each year, dozens of books and articles, as well as hundreds of seminars and conferences offer ideas, inspiration, techniques and methods of success and prosperity. Two of the most popular TV game shows in recent years, namely, "Survivor" and "The Weakest Link", promote the outlook of winning at all cost. On both shows, contestants will do anything to outlast the others. It's "survival of the fittest." They encourage people to elbow their way to the top, regardless of who gets hurt.


Jesus, however, turns that mentality on its head when he says, "Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth." For the kingdom of God, it is not "survival of the fittest." It is the person who is willing to step aside and let God take control.

In Philippians 2, Paul urges us to have the mind of Christ. Our attitude, says Paul, must be "the same as that of Christ Jesus." We need to look to Jesus, and learn from Him. By the power of the Holy Spirit, we can live like our Lord, who became meek for our sake, but is now King over all things in heaven and on earth.

Reflection: What is success? For many, success is equated with independence, fame and power. True success is accepting God's goal for our lives and by His grace becoming what He has called us to be.

Prayer: Lord, give us the courage to be as meek as you are. Forgive us for being more concerned about our well-being and our own success, rather than serving you and people around us. In your name, Amen.





### **Sunday: Significance**

*Matthew 5:6 "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled."*

Why is it never enough? The rich young man in Matthew 19 (verses 16-22) had it all. He was young and rich. He must have the envy of most people. Being young and rich means that you are really somebody. Who does not want to be as successful as he was?


However, within each of us there is always a hunger for more. More is not enough. That is why even this rich young man came to Jesus. Jesus insightfully pointed out his problem. This rich young man was hungering for the wrong thing. Jesus challenged him to sell all he had and give his money to the poor.


Jesus knows that the man's possession had taken control of his life.

By contrast, Eric Liddell, perhaps Scotland's greatest athlete of all time, illustrated well a life full of significance and meaning. His story was made famous by the Oscar-winning movie, "Chariots of Fire". For Eric, to please God is his highest ambition. Thus, after winning his Olympic Gold medal in Paris, he soon went to China as an exemplary missionary and educator. He died in a Japanese concentration camp in China just before the end of WWII. Paul Henderson, our own Canadian Olympic hero, observed, "striving for glory is relatively easy, but living for others is much more difficult. The setting aside of self is mastered by few, but Eric Liddell was such a man."

Reflection: What is forgotten in time is of little significance. What is remembered for eternity is of greatest significance.

Prayer: Lord, give us grace to become hungry for the right thing. Take away our constant desire for more of the wrong thing. Fill us with your Holy Spirit. In Your name, Amen.
